**All rates may be subject to the following Rate Schedule Riders:**

**Power Cost Adjustment (PCA)** – The PCA is a direct pass-through of any charges or credits that MiEnergy Cooperative receives from our wholesale power supplier to account for fluctuations in the energy market.

**Standby Power:** Charges required to any non-residential member who requires 100 kW or more of standby capacity from the cooperative.

**Street Lighting:** Includes Company, Municipal, or Residential Lighting.

**Tax Adjustment:** Includes federal, state or local tax charges in addition to any franchise fees.

**Cogeneration Small Power Producers:** Net Energy, Purchase & Sale, Time of Day and Distributed Generation.

**Conservation Improvement Program Cost Recovery Adjustment:** The amount dedicated to the recovery of CIP costs (i.e. energy efficiency rebates for cooling, lighting, appliances, etc.) as approved by the Minnesota PUC and adjusted annually.

**Alternative Transaction Adjustment Credit (ATA)** – An adjustment due to the ITC transmission line sale and will be in effect until approximately 2017.

**Residential and Non-Residential SecondNature Renewable Energy Program** – Voluntary purchase of renewable energy

**Co-op Ownership Adjustment** – An adjustment as a result of the sale from Alliant Energy to Tri-County Electric and reflects the savings of Cooperative ownership.
